SUBJECT: Port St. Lucie Police seized 1.25 pounds of Marijuana and \$1,470.00 in cash during an early evening drug raid.

On February 10, 2016 at around 8:30 pm, Detectives with the Port St. Lucie Police Special Investigations Division arrested **Jack Grant Maxwell (DOB 3/11/85, 1621 SE Mariner Lane, Port St. Lucie)** for possession of more than 20 grams of Marijuana, possession of Marijuana with intent to sell – three counts, possession of Clonazepam without a prescription, possession of a harmful new legend drug without a prescription, sale of Cocaine, possession of Cocaine, sale of Marijuana – two counts, illegal use of a two way communication device – three counts, and possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Detectives also arrested **Gregory Dale-Edward Madden (DOB 4/12/80, 1621 SE Mariner Lane, Port St. Lucie)** for possession of more than 20 grams of Marijuana, possession of Marijuana with intent to sell, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

The narcotics investigation began in December, 2015, when an undercover detective bought Marijuana and Cocaine from Maxwell on three separate occasions. During the investigation, Detectives with the Port St. Lucie Police Special Investigations Division secured a drug search warrant for Maxwell's home located in the 1600 block of SE Mariner Lane.

On Wednesday, February 10, 2016, detectives searched Maxwell's home and seized approximately 1.25 pounds of Marijuana, \$1,470.00 in cash, two pills of Clonazepam, one pill of Hydroxyzine, and drug paraphernalia.

Maxwell was arrested just prior to the search of his home after detectives conducted a traffic stop on his car. Madden was arrested after he pulled into the driveway of the SE Mariner home while

detectives were still conducting their search. Both Maxwell and Madden were taken to the St. Lucie County Jail for booking.
