SUBJECT: Father and son car burglary duo arrested in Port St. Lucie.

On January 12, 2016, Port St. Lucie Police arrested William Charles Gallway (DOB 12/27/64, Homeless) and his son, Anthony William Gallway (DOB 2/9/90, Homeless, Port St. Lucie), on two counts of burglary to a conveyance and two counts of grand theft after they broke into two cars on the North end of the City.

On January 12, 2016 at around 9:00 am, Port St. Lucie Police received two car burglary reports, one in the 300 Block of NW Stratford Lane and the other in the 400 block of NW Stratford Lane. Between the two car burglaries over \$1,600.00 was taken to include over a \$1,000.00 in E-Cigarette retail supplies and a Garmin GPS unit.

Learning of the burglaries on NW Stratford lane, Officer Kneidel recalled checking out with a father and son who had set a small camp fire in the woods earlier in the morning. The area of the camp fire was in close proximity to the burglaries and Officer Kneidel communicated to the other officers in the area to be on the lookout for the Gallways. Shortly after the search for the suspects, Officer Chamberlin located the Gallaways in front of the Circle K located in the 700 block of NW Airoso Boulevard.

After questioning the Gallways, Officer Kneidel discovered that the E-Cigarette merchandise was put in a plastic trash bag and stashed along a house located in the 1000 block of NW Bayshore Boulevard. The stolen Garmin GPS was located in William's personal belongings.
