Southport Wastewater Booster Pump Station to run on electrical generator for the next several days

PORT ST. LUCIE, FLA. – An electrical breaker failed today at the City’s Southport Wastewater Booster Pump Station that is located east of Pine Valley Drive on the site of the former Southport Wastewater Treatment Plant.

A replacement breaker has been ordered, but according to the manufacturer, the estimated build time for the specialty part is 3-4 business days.

In the meantime, electrical power for the station must be provided 24/7 by an emergency diesel generator, which may prompt noise complaints from the residents of neighboring homes. Please know that generator power is the only alternative power source available.

It is hoped that the replacement part will be delivered by the end of next week. Please be assured that every effort will be made to return the station to normal operation as quickly as possible.
