**SUBJECT: Port St. Lucie Police investigating damage caused by suspected BB gun shootings**

Port St. Lucie Police is investigating 4 reported vandalism complaints suspected to be linked to BB gun shootings in the center of the City. The incidents occurred between Thursday, April 28, 2016 and Friday, April 29, 2016.

The following is the locations, dates, times, and extent of damage reported:

- 1700 block SW Brisbane Street, April 28, 2016 at 7:51 pm, rear vehicle window shattered
- 300 block SW Thornhill Drive, April 28, 2016 at 8:19 pm, rear vehicle window shattered
- 400 block SW Prado Avenue, between April 28, 2016 at 11:00 pm to April 29, 2016 at 6:20 am, two vehicles rear windows shattered and hole in front window of house
- 1900 block SE Airoso Boulevard, between April 28, 2016 at 6:00 pm to April 29, 2016 at 11:00 am, dents on side of vehicle.

Possible suspect vehicle seen in the area of the SW Brisbane Street vandalism is described as an unknown black SUV. There was no description given of suspects inside the SUV.


