### **SUBJECT: Bomb threat at Treasure Coast High School**

On May 23, 2016 shortly after 11:00 am, school staff at Treasure Coast High School, located at 1000 SW Darwin Boulevard, Port St. Lucie, received a phone call from an unidentified caller stating that there was a bomb in the school. Port St. Lucie Police along with the St. Lucie County Sheriff's Office and St. Lucie County School Security responded to the school. Students have been evacuated as law enforcement works with school personnel to clear the school of any potential hazards.

Students are not being released at this time and no one is permitted to enter the school grounds while the search of the building is conducted.

On May 23, 2016 at 12:45 pm, the "All Clear" was given for students at Treasure Coast High School to resume normal school day functions. There was no suspicious packages or bombs found on campus and Students were ushered back into the building.

The investigation into the bomb threat is still ongoing and is an active investigation.
