
### City of Port St. Lucie: Latest Information on Storm Debris Cleanup Update # 4

PORT ST. LUCIE (November 1, 2016) – The City of Port St. Lucie continues to work toward its goal of having all storm-related debris cleared by Friday.

The Debris Management Team has inspection teams evaluating roadways in order to determine if a second collection pass is necessary in areas where residents have placed debris after the first collection.

Residents should avoid placing debris under power lines near swale liners, mailboxes, sign posts and fire hydrants as these items might be damaged during the collection process.

The map below illustrates city zones.



The City is working to fulfill its commitment to have streets cleared by the end of this week. Below is the latest information on individual zones:

- Zone 1 is 95% complete, Residents can expect to have all streets cleared by November 1, 2016
- Zone 2 is 100% complete
- Zone 3 is 100% complete
- Zone 4 is 50% complete, Residents can expect to have all streets cleared by November 4, 2016
- Zone 5 is 55% complete, Residents can expect to have all streets cleared by November 4, 2016
- Zone 6 is 35% complete, Residents can expect to have all streets cleared by November 4, 2016
- Zone 7 is 37% complete, Residents can expect to have all streets cleared by November 4, 2016
- Zone 8 is 100% complete
- Zone 9 is 100% complete.
- Zone 10 is 42% complete, Residents can expect to have all streets cleared by November 4, 2016
- Zone 11 is 42% complete, Residents can expect to have all streets cleared by November 4, 2016
- Zone 12 is 55% complete, Residents can expect to have all streets cleared by November 4, 2016
- Zone 13 is 65% complete, Residents can expect to have all streets cleared by November 4, 2016
- Zone 14 is 100% complete
