SUBJECT: Port St Lucie Police investigating fatal crash; car vs. pedestrian at SE Port St. Lucie Boulevard and SE Airoso Boulevard

On October 3, 2016 at around 6:40 am, Port St. Lucie Police went to the intersection of SE Port St. Lucie Boulevard and SE Airoso Boulevard to investigate a car crash; pedestrian vs. SUV.

Preliminary investigation revealed that 50 year old Antonette Bauman (DOB 8/8/66, 591 SE Chapman Avenue, Port St. Lucie) was walking south on SE Airoso Boulevard and crossed the west bound lanes of SE Port St. Lucie Boulevard and made it to the concrete median half way across the street. Bauman attempted to cross the east bound lane of SE Port St. Lucie Boulevard when she was struck by a 2009 Blue Chevrolet Blazer, driven by Ivan Declet (1/19/74, 3249 SW Esperanto Avenue, Port St. Lucie), who was traveling east on SE Port St. Lucie Boulevard. Witnesses at the scene told police that the east and west bound traffic of Port St. Lucie Boulevard had a green light when the crash occurred.

Bauman sustained severe trauma to the body and was transported to St. Lucie Medical Center where she was pronounced dead at the hospital. Declet was not injured during the crash. No charges are pending at this time as Traffic Homicide Investigators continue their investigation.
