Meet the Port St. Lucie City Manager Finalists

What: Meet & Greet City Manager Candidate Finalists

When: Friday, October 7 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Who: Four City Manager Candidate Finalists

Why: The public will have an opportunity to meet and ask questions of the four candidates who are being considered for the position of Port St. Lucie City Manager. The meet-and-greet will be between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. on Friday, Oct. 7. Earlier that day, each of the candidates will meet with each City Council member for one-on-one interviews. The City Council is expected to vote at its Oct. 10 meeting on its top choice for the job. After that, Council, the executive recruiting consultant and City staff will work with the selected candidate on an employment agreement. The start date of the new City Manager will be determined as part of the contract negotiations.
