One out of five children online have been solicited for sex. Similar numbers of young people have been hurt by a cyber-bully, a stalker, or rumors. The website www.secureflorida.org provides a quiz for kids on safe practices as well as information for parents, parents rules, and kids rules.

If anyone sends unwanted e-mails to you, you should print it out & save it, then send them one and only one e-mail telling them to STOP communicating with you. NEVER RESPOND to another e-mail from them again.

Always give your password to your parent or guardian. Your parents will then be able to retrieve recent messages in the event you go missing. Never give it to anyone else; even a best friend can forget to safeguard your password and let it get into the wrong hands.
