Construction is expected to be completed by November 21st, 2016

Location: West Side of SE Veterans Memorial Parkway, South of Lyngate Dr.

Description:

This project entails the demolition and replacement of two (2) existing wooden pedestrian bridges on the west side of SE Veterans Memorial Pkwy. The existing wooden bridges were installed over 20 years ago and are showing signs of rotting and general degradation. Repair is not a feasible option, so replacement is recommended. The new bridges will be painted steel truss, which will require much less maintenance and will provide a longer life cycle.

One of the bridges is located just south of the southern entrance to Lyngate Park. The other is located just south of the lake, which is located south of Lyngate Park.

Progress:

All design is complete. Contractor has been selected and contract was approved by City Council on March 28th, 2016. Construction is underway and will be completed by November 21st, 2016.

Current Conditions: Bridges have been placed and sidewalks have been constructed. Contractor is sodding disturbed areas, waiting on delivery and installation of handrail, and then the project will be complete.
